(Kansai Airport-Kobe-Kyoto-Osaka-USJ-Narita Airport)

Day 1

Arrive at Kansai Airport

- **Himeji Castle**-It is also known as White Heron Castle (Shirasagijo) due to its elegant, white appearance, is widely considered Japan's most spectacular castle for its imposing size and beauty and its well preserved, complex castle grounds. The castle is both a national treasure and a world heritage site.



- **Kobe Harbourland** -It is a shopping and entertainment district between JR Kobe Station and the waterfront of Kobe's port area. The district offers a large selection of shops, restaurants, cafes and other amusements, which, together with the romantic evening atmosphere, have made it a popular spot for couples and tourists alike.



- **Kitano Ijinkan**- It is a city district at the foot of the Rokko mountain range where many foreign merchants and diplomats settled after the Port of Kobe was opened to foreign trade in the second half of the 19th century. More than a dozen of the former mansions, known as Ijinkan, remain in the area and are open to the public as museums.

Day 2

- **Miyama Folk Museum**-The folk museum exhibits a large collection of traditional tools and artifacts from Miyama's past, the art gallery stages rotating exhibitions by various artists.
- **Kiyomizu Temple**-Kiyomizudera is one of the most celebrated temples of Japan. It was founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto, and derives its name from the fall's pure waters.



- **Kinkaku-Ji** -Kinkakuji is a Zen temple in northern Kyoto whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf.

Day 3

- **Universal Studio Japan-It** was the first theme park under the Universal Studios brand to be built in Asia. Opened in March 2001 in the Osaka Bay Area, the theme park occupies an area of 39 hectares and is the most visited amusement park in Japan after Tokyo Disney Resort.



Day 4

Departs from Kansai Airport
